

## BURSARY/SKILLS PROGRAMME OPPORTUNITY

The Company has established a Bursary, and all Bursaries are granted for a period of one academic year of study only and are awarded at the sole and absolute discretion of The Company.

The Bursary is offered to a Learner between the age of 17 (seventeen) and 25 (twenty-five) years old who achieves a minimum of 70% (seventy percentage) in Matric. The Learner must consent to have a criminal background check conducted.

The Bursary specifically targets the empowerment of previously disadvantaged individuals. Thus, the Bursary Programmes are available only to eligible South African citizens who are black people as defined in the Broad-based Black Economic Act, No. 53 of 2003 and the Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice, 2007 as amended, and who choose a course of study in any of the below mentioned fields and are granted towards the following types of qualifications, offered by accredited Higher Education Institution only, and at any levels:

The Following Qualifications will be preferred, but others may be considered as well:

- Mechanical engineering
- Chemical engineering
- Process engineering
- Metallurgical engineering

4. Matric certificate
5. Latest academic transcript/record
6. Latest statement/invoice from the Institution
7. Lease agreement and the outstanding invoice
